

### SUCCESSFUL SUBMISSION TO AMSA

We have been most fortunate to have been successful in a funding submission to the Australian Men's Shed Association's National Shed Development Program. We have now a wide range of high quality tools for woodwork and metal work projects. The equipment granted includes a sand blasting unit, a Pressbrake, guillotine & rolls unit, a tool sharpening unit a quality compressor and a welding safety helmet.

The compressor will be housed along with the vacuum plant in its own external room adjoining the SHED and will be linked to a loom of hoses that allow tools to be used from different locations within the SHED.

The tool sharpening unit will allow us to sharpen our own tools as well as providing an opportunity to invite community members to have their favourite knives and scissors sharpened by members who have been trained to use this machine.

A new LED lighting plant for the SHED will also be installed from this grant.
